- 3. 4th QUARTER: LMHS 4th Quarter will end on Wednesday, June 3.
 - a. <u>LMHS will continue with our LMHS 4th Quarter Virtual Universe Schedule for the remainder of the school year.</u>
 - b. *CALENDAR*:
 - 1. Friday, May 8 is NOT a Professional Development Day. COMPASS classes will be in session on this day.
 - 2. Memorial Day is on Monday, May 25. During this week, the 'Tuesday + Thursday' course schedule will remain the same. The 'Monday + Wednesday' course schedule will become a 'Wednesday + Friday' course schedule for Wednesday, May 27 and Friday, May 29.
 - **3.** We will NOT run a 'finals' schedule and will use the current *LMHS 4th Quarter Virtual Universe Schedule* for June 1 and 2. June 3 will be designated as a 'make-up' or 'remediation' day for students.
 - c. <u>SCHEDULE</u>: All classes are meeting using a *LMHS 4th Quarter Virtual Universe Schedule* (on the school webpage).

- d. <u>LIVE/TEAMS SESSIONS</u>: Please use your school computers for 'live' sessions. We have found that these work much better than your phones. LMHS Teachers will be using Teams for most video conferencing at this time. (All school-issued computers are installed with Teams). The district has received a temporary Zoom EDU license so teachers may be using Zoom now for some class sessions.
 - 1. Expectations and Rules of Engagement for Students regarding 'Live'/Teams Sessions:
 - a. No recording or posting of sessions should be done without permission from the class teacher.
 - b. Always be appropriate during any session. Disruptive or and inappropriate behavior may result in a student being restricted from attending 'live' class sessions.
 - c. Please mute your screen when you are not speaking during a session to avoid background noise or disruptions.
 - d. Please inform your teacher via email if you are unable to make a session for any reason so that they can communicate with you and ensure you have the new content and assignments/projects.
- e. <u>ATTENDANCE</u>: Teachers are taking attendance for the scheduled class sessions as required by the Dept. of Ed. when having 'mandated, graded for credit, online' classes. Please continue to communicate with your teacher if you have responsibilities that will keep you from attending a scheduled 'live' class session.
- f. JOINING YOUR ONLINE CLASS SESSION: Students may 'join' their class sessions in two different ways:
 - 1. If your teacher sent you a link to 'join' a class session, then simply 'click' on the link just before the class is scheduled to start. (We have discouraged this method to staff)
 - 2. Go to Outlook Calendar or the Microsoft Teams Calendar, 'click' on the class and 'join' just before the class is scheduled to start. (recommended method)
- g. <u>COMMUNICATION</u>: Our teachers are working hard to communicate with parents and students each day regarding course work questions students may have. Please know that if you email teachers after 3:30 p.m. you may not receive a response until the next morning.
- h. <u>GRADING</u>: All 4th Quarter/2nd Semester classes will be graded and issuing credit. Due to the extreme circumstance impacting all of our students and families at this time and the online nature of the instruction for at least a significant portion of 4th Quarter, students will have some options regarding grading provided certain criteria is met (document on grading: https://www.linnmar.k12.ia.us/wp-content/uploads/2020/04/Grading-for-2nd-Semester-4th-Quarter-in-2019-20-1.pdf).

- 1. IEP Meetings continue to be held via video/phone conference.
- j. <u>TUTORING</u>: Two sources of tutoring are available for students during our virtual school time. To contact the Tutoring Center in the Learning Center, please email <u>rebecca.cortez@linnmar.k12.ia.us</u>. The LMHS MASS Tutoring Center is happy to be offering free online tutoring for both high school and middle school students in math and science classes and ACT/SAT. There will be one-on-one tutoring sessions that will be 30-60 minutes, depending on the student's preference, through Microsoft Teams. - k. <u>END of 4th Quarter/Return of Course Materials and School-Issued Computers</u>: 12th Grade material return will take place on Wednesday, May 20. We will have material drop off days for 9th, 10th, and 11th Grades at the end of the term. We will finalize procedures and dates for 9th, 10th, and 11th Grade material drop off in the next couple of weeks. Anticipate this may be on June 1, 2, 3, and 4. You will be receiving a billing statement to show what is checked out to you (or your student). This is not meant to panic anyone. It is the easiest way for us to let you know what you currently have checked out and will be required for check-in of materials on May 20 (for 12th grade) and June 1-5 (for 9th, 10th, and 11th grades). You do NOT need to submit any payments if you have all of the items on the list and return at your scheduled check-in time. This list may not include all textbooks.

- 4. <u>TECHNOLOGY SUPPORT</u>: "Hey, I'm having issues with my school-issued computer. Since I cannot take it to the HELP Desk in the Learning Center at this time, what should I do?" 6. The LMHS Class of 2020:

- a. <u>Senior Recognition Night</u>: Senior Recognition Night (May 11) and Senior Department Awards (May 13) will not be 'in-person' events this year. Senior Recognition will be revealed in a slide show format to be released on or before May 20.
- b. Seniors last day is Wednesday, May 20. At assigned times, Seniors will be returning school-issued computers/chargers and all other school and extra-curricular equipment/materials/clothing. A specific information sheet for this day is planned to be sent to Seniors next week.
- c. Specific Graduation scenarios were sent to staff, students and parents. These are posted on the district website. The final decision for which scenario will be used is planned to take place on Monday, May 11, so that appropriate planning may take place. Within each scenario, our objective is to preserve honoring each student by having her/his name called, walking the stage and receiving her/his diploma. We also understand that anything short of the traditional ceremony with the entire class in attendance at the same time will be a disappointment to many if not most students.
- d. <u>Cap/Gown/Stole/Tassel Distribution</u>: Caps, Gowns, Stoles and Tassels will be distributed following an assigned schedule on Monday, May 11. An information sheet and specific pick up schedule were emailed to all Seniors and parents yesterday. These are also posted on the LM website. Seniors, do NOT put any markings on your cap prior to 'walking' and receiving your diploma.
- e. Scholarship Information: Scholarships are still available for Seniors. Scholarships can be found on a student's Naviance Student account by clicking on the Colleges tab, Scholarships and Money, Scholarship List. If students need help accessing scholarships or have any questions, they can reach out to their school counselor.
- f. Seniors received an email yesterday for each of you to complete a final transcript request and postsecondary intentions survey prior to May 20. Thank you for your attention to this.
- g. Alliant Energy is planning to light their tower in downtown Cedar Rapids to honor 2020 graduates. Starting May 21, they will light the tower in the colors of an area high school. Sunday, May 24th is Linn-Mar's night.
