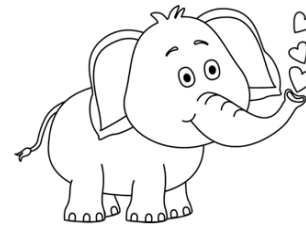
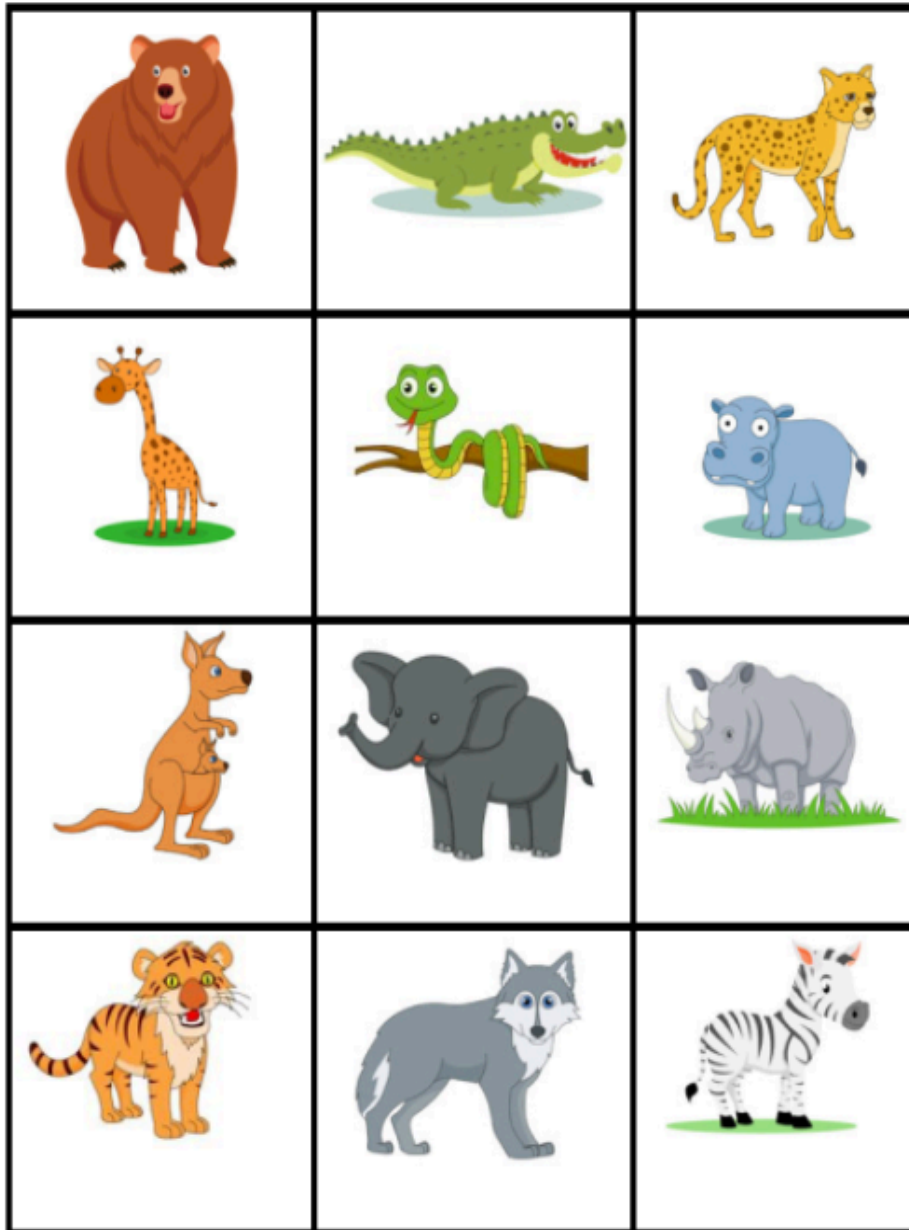


## SCAVENGER HUNT

## Zoo Games

### Syllable Sort or Syllable Hop

1. Cut cards out and put in a pile.

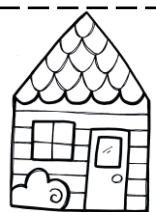

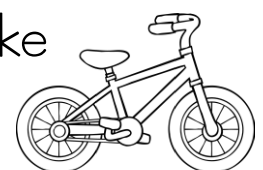

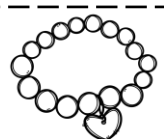
