Pretend Play

Pretend you are a traffic person and play stop and go. No sign? No worries you can simply say green light/red light, stop/go, or make a sign.



Outdoor Play

Freeze some watercolor paint, food coloring water, or just water. Go outside and paint on the sidewalk. Add sticks, popsicle sticks, toothpicks, etc for the brush if needed.

Camping Fun at Home

Use blankets or use a play tent to make a tent. Add some blankets and flashlights! You can even make a pretend fire with empty toilet paper rolls! Snuggle up and read a book. (If it's a rainy day, do it inside. Otherwise you can do it outside!)



Bubble Art

1. Pour a small amount of bubbles into each bowl (1 bowl for each color you want to use.)
2. Add about 5 drops of food coloring to each bowl, making each bowl of bubbles a different color.
3. Stir your bubbles well.
4. Lay white paper or cardstock onto the grass or sidewalk, dip your wand into the colored bubbles and blow onto your white card stock.
5. Let dry and display.

Use an ice cream scoop or spoon and rolled up socks. Scoop up the socks and put them into a dish. How many socks can you fit in the dish?



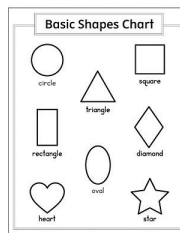
Water Play



Fill a bucket with water and use sponges as a way to transfer water from one dish to another, or as the 'balloon' for a water balloon fight.

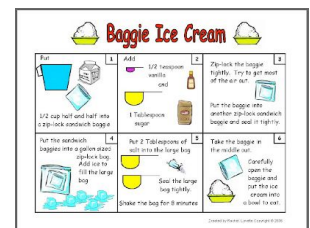
Shape Hunt
