Most people think that "Tornado Sirens" and an annoying buzzing notification on your screen are the only forms of warning, and that a majority of the time they are false. This is why people lose their lives in tornadoes, they subconsciously ignore warnings and these severe threats because when they get a tornado warning, a tornado does not hit their house. Some people get fed up with AMBER alerts and disable those, and weather warnings while they're at it.

The Siren system is designed to warn people outside in the event of an emergency, this doesn't just include weather. In the event of an attack on the US from another country, such and an invasion or nuclear strike, they will sound an attack tone. You will most likely never experience this in your lifetime, if you do the world is probably ending.

So with that in mind, let's go over the August 10 event, as it was a mind boggling day in the weather community. Usually the routine of a weather geek is wake up, pick up phone, and go check the Storm Prediction Center severe outlooks. If you looked at August 9th's outlook for August 10th, it wouldn't even cross your mind as a historic event. Most weather geeks woke up on the morning of August 10th to an absolutely insane event that was already unfolding. (See the August 10th Diagram)

So when there's a tornado warning, a tornado probably won't destroy your house, but it can, so with that in mind, always find a safe and structurally sound place to hide in that event. Most tornadoes are rain wrapped and are totally invisible until it is too late. Be sure to read the details of a warning as well, it will provide an in-depth explanation of the situation, you can download the KCRG app and view the details of the warning. In the case of the derecho, it was clearly stated that widespread 100 MPH winds had already caused damage and were imminent to hit the CR Area.

In short, take shelter during a Tornado Warning, and a Severe Thunderstorm Warning in which the sirens are sounded. We understand weather more now than ever, but it is still extremely unpredictable in some cases.

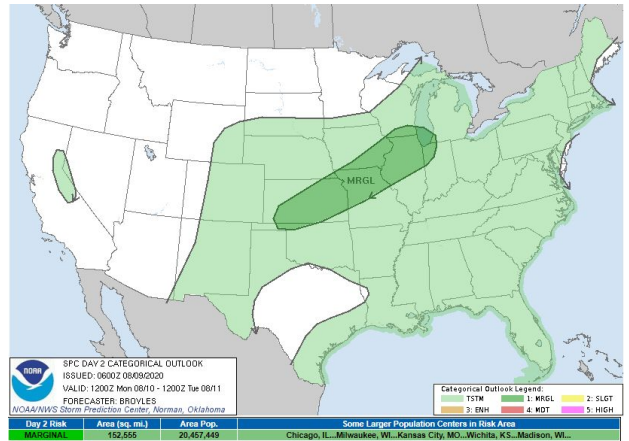
Iowa Basketball Coach's Sentence Upheld

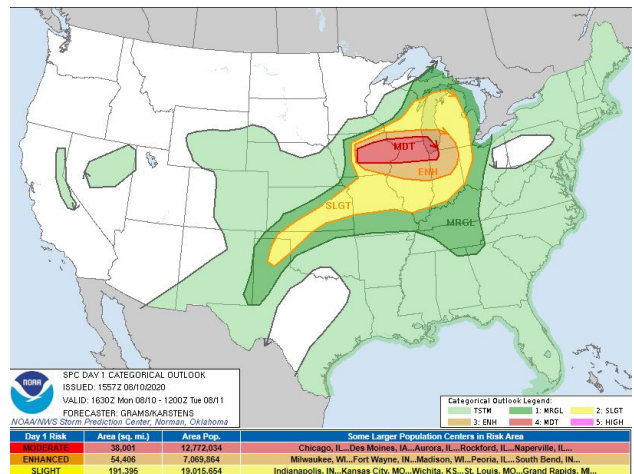
A Federal appeals court upheld the life sentence Monday on an Iowa youth basketball coach, who exploited more than 400 boys over the last 20 years. A panel of the U.S Circuit Court of Appeals rejected Greg Stephen's argument that the 180-year sentence was not fitting and excessive because he did not physically injure or kill his victims. Stephen coached with Iowa's most promising basketball players as a coach of the Iowa Barnstormers. The Barnstormers compete nationally and are sponsored by Adidas, many teens Stephen coached earned scholarships from schools such as Wisconsin, Northern Iowa, and Iowa. Stephen would pretend to be a female and lure them into sending explicit videos and pictures. Stephen would also secretly record players undressing in the bathrooms in the hotels at tournaments. Stephen will be serving his sentence in federal penitentiary in Tucson, Arizona.

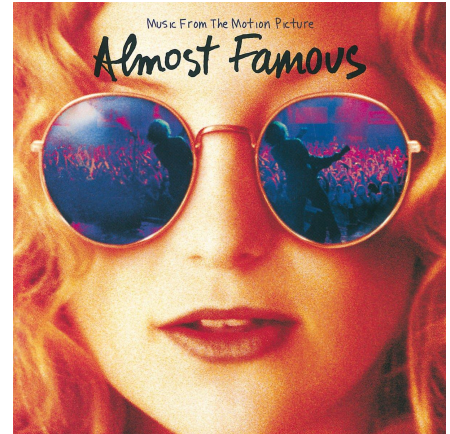
Terrorist Strike on Civilians in Mali

That being said, this still is a great option as it has the Ryzen 5 3600 on AMD's Zen 2 Architecture as it has 6 cores and 12 threads this CPU will not bottleneck the 5500 XT, on the other hand the ram is in single channel and the Ryzen series is known to want to run in dual channel, and with its single stick of DDR4, you may want to upgrade it. Lastly it only has a 240GB ssd and most of today's games are in the 100 gigabyte range, and they call this a gaming PC, yet you'll only be able to hold one or two games on it unless you're playing smaller indie style or e-sports games. All in all, this is a pretty good option if you're on a budget.

Remembering Ram Dass (1931-2019)

“In 1961, while at Harvard, explorations of human consciousness led Ram Dass, in collaboration with Timothy Leary, Ralph Metzner, Aldous Huxley, and Allen Ginsberg, to pursue intensive research with psilocybin, LSD-25, and other psychedelic chemicals. Out of this research came two books: *The Psychedelic Experience* (co-authored with Leary and Metzner, and based on *The Tibetan Book of the Dead*, published by University Books); and *LSD* (with Sidney Cohen and Lawrence Schiller, published by New American Library). Because of the highly controversial nature of their research, Richard Alpert and Timothy Leary became personae non-grata and were dismissed from Harvard in 1963. Tim Leary and Alpert then went to Mexico, ate mushrooms, and went from being academics to counter-culture icons, legends in their own time, and young at that. For Ram Dass psychedelic work turned out to be a prelude to the mystical country of the spirit and the source of consciousness itself. Mind expansion via chemical substances became a catalyst for the spiritual seeking. This naturally led him eastward to the traditional headwater of mystical rivers, India. Once there, a series of seeming coincidences led him to Neem Karoli Baba and the transformation from Richard Alpert to Ram Dass.”

How Ram Dass Has Impacted My Life:

Through the several hours I've spent reading and listening to Ram Dass one thing I've been coming to understand is how to just be with myself. His understanding has offered me a place to see a glimpse of my soul through that which is reflected. Reflection is an unitary skill that requires consolidation with oneself, and the other (however you may perceive “the other”) and it is something most of us avoid, whether we know it or not; gravity pulls things together and “like attracts like.” Ram Dass has an invigorating sense of perception that takes people into higher states of awareness or being that which come close to the inexplicable.

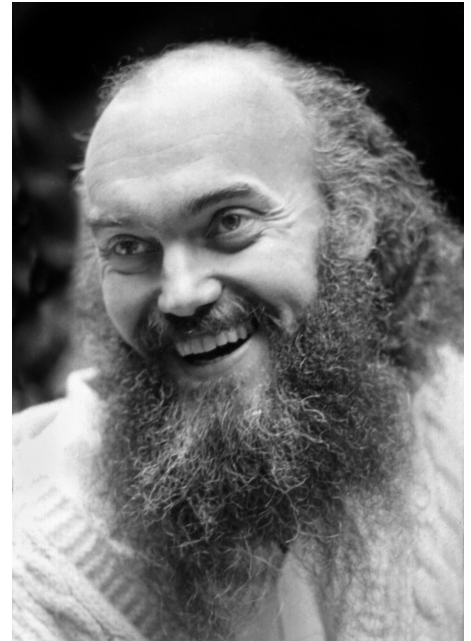

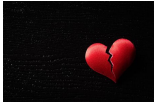

The Way Marion Was

Marion is its own independent city, much like Hiawatha and Robins, but is still directly connected to Cedar Rapids. The sole reason that Marion was founded in 1839 was because in the 1830's, the railroad came to town. A Regional RR had built a line from Dubuque, carrying many goods and passengers, however the passengers described it as an awful and slow way to travel, but just two years later, the Chicago, Milwaukee and St Paul Railroad, AKA "The Milwaukee Road" had purchased the line from Dubuque and a line from Council Bluffs to Sabula, IA.

In the 1950's The MILW had just discontinued its premiere passenger train through Marion, "The Midwest Hiawatha," which featured a steam locomotive capable of holding 100 MPH. Although trains only were permitted for 80 through town, as a replacement, the Union Pacific and the Milwaukee Road entered an agreement in 1955 to join together and run Diesel powered passenger trains across the country, utilizing both companies' equipment and trackage, ending a previous contract with the Chicago and Northwestern, which owned a Transcon line a few miles south, and all the way up until March 30, 1971 with the creation of Amtrak, which was the US's nationalized passenger train company. There was no replacement train created and regular passenger service would end forever.

On Occasion, Amtrak would run detours through Marion if the ATSF line had become obstructed by a Wreck or Flooding. However this did not mean you could board the train in Marion, at least not at normal prices...

In 1964, Marion was one of the busiest places on the MILW system, 30 trains east and west totalled out to 60 trains a day, almost a train every 15 to 20 minutes at that point. Only 13 years later, in 1977, the Milwaukee Road would declare bankruptcy and abandon the Pacific Extension in the Northwest. This severely dropped the traffic on the Transcon, as a result, there were only 15 trains a day in summer of 1977. By New Year's 1980, track speed was 10 MPH from Marion to Sabula due to worsening track conditions.

On March 1, 1980 at 5PM, MILW train 106 arrived in Marion, picked up cars, and unsurprisingly, had No drop offs, and departed Marion. Later that summer in June of 1980, a "cleanup train" came into Marion to gather all remaining rail equipment on property. This was the last **Train** to run through Marion. In the mid 80's the lines East and West of Marion were abandoned and the tracks were ripped up and scrapped. A small portion of line into Marion stayed in place until 2005 when the last customer, Marion Iron, decided to move and no longer receive rail service. It is crazy to think that 2000 tons of metal once flew down 6th Avenue at 80MPH, but now you can only go 25....

Trains are the heaviest moving objects on land, as I type this, today's CN M338 is 18,000 tons. Clearly, that's a lot of weight, and making that mass move requires a mind boggling amount of horsepower, and to bring it to a stop, requires even more. Legally, there must be a posted phone number on every railroad crossing in the US. In short, a train will not stop in time, like ever, so it is essential that you and your vehicle stay off the tracks and cross safely.

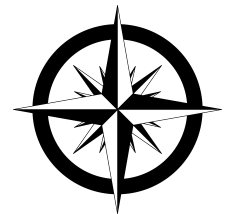


Twitter Bans President Donald Trump Permanently
