# Online School Year Registration

- Log on to your PowerSchool account and look on the left-hand side scrolling down until you see the word "Forms".
- Click on the word "Forms".
- Look for the "Enrollment" tab across the top and click on "Enrollment".
- You should be routed to the "Student Demographics" page (if not, click on "Student Demographics")
- Make any changes or additions to the electronic form and click submit at the bottom of the page.
- Click okay.
- You will now see the next screen to make changes or updates.
- Repeat the whole process until you have completed each screen.

#### Campus Release for the 2021-2022 School Year Returns to 'Earned' Status

Campus Release (formerly known as 'Time Release') will return to 'earned' status for grades 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. Campus Release will not be available for 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students. An 'earned' status means that Campus Release can be taken away for disciplinary, attendance, and academic reasons. Parent permission must also be granted for a 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grades student to have Campus Release. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students will not have Campus Release for the 2021-2022 school year. However, 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students without RTI needs will be able to leave at 3:38 p.m. each Monday and Friday with signed parent permission. *See specific grade-level sections in the Updates for a copy of the campus release permission form.* 

#### Student Parking for the 2021-2022 School Year

We are returning to more restrictive parking for the 2021-2022 school year. Only vehicles with the proper LMHS parking tag will be permitted in the designated on-campus parking lots from 8:45 a.m.-3:45 p.m. Any 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade student who registers a vehicle will be eligible for a parking permit on campus. Parking Tags will again cost \$25.00 for the school year. 10<sup>th</sup> Grade students will have a limited number of parking spaces in the Stadium East/Aquatic Center Lot area. A parking lottery will be held for 10<sup>th</sup> Grade students eligible to park on campus on August 17. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students will not be issued parking tags for campus and will need to park on off campus streets. Parking Tags will be issued to 12<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade students starting Monday, August 9, in the Deans Office (formerly the 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Grades Office). 10<sup>th</sup> Grade students may sign up for the parking tag lottery from Monday, August 9, through Friday, August 13, in the Deans Office. #### 9th Grade Connection for 2021-2022

We continue to build off our 9<sup>th</sup> Grade-Only 1<sup>st</sup> Day concept, which is aimed at helping students prepare for the first days of high school with all grade-levels. This year, we are adding an initiative with a year-long focus to support 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students making and maintaining a successful adjustment to high school. Our daily 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Connection will involve every LMHS teacher and 9<sup>th</sup> Grade student with the focus of having a specific teacher who gets to know the student, can help answer questions regarding school-related information, can monitor academic progress daily, can provide executive functioning (organization, planning, prioritizing) support, and will also provide focused study time. Each teacher will be assigned 4-6 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students who will meet each day opposite lunch each day and also during RTI time on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday if a student is not working with another teacher during RTI.

Form 3:38 is a parent permission form for 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students to leave the building at 3:38 p.m. on any Mondays and Friday provided their student is not requested nor requesting RTI at 3:38 p.m. Students not having a signed form and not requested nor requesting RTI for any Monday or Friday will remain in their 4<sup>th</sup> Block/8<sup>th</sup> Period classrooms until 4:00 p.m. This is the only time 9<sup>th</sup> Grade students may be released early during a regular school day.
