Depression Screening

The teen years, not even factoring in the pandemic, are marked by a rollercoaster ride of emotions – difficult for teens, their parents, and educators. Linn Mar counselors will be offering Depression Screening the first two weeks in March for those who have a consent form with parental approval. They are focusing on 9th and 10th grades for screenings, however, 11th and 12th students will be screened upon parent request. This tool cannot provide a diagnosis of depression, but it does give an indication of whether a young person should be referred for evaluation by a mental health professional. <u>FAFSA</u> – If you have not yet filed the FAFSA, many <u>priority deadlines</u> are quickly approaching. Follow these easy steps to file at home:

- 1. Create an FSA ID for your student and one parent. <u>studentaid.gov/FSA-ID</u>
 - a. Make sure to save your username and password for future FAFSA filings and verify your email and phone number
- 2. Go to www.FAFSA.gov to start your application.
 - a. List of items you need to file the FAFSA.
 - b. File the 2022-2023 Form for students starting college in Fall 2023.
 - c. Check out the Federal Student Aid Page Dedicated to the FAFSA Process: https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/filling-out.

File the FAFSA with assistance from ICAN by <u>making an appointment on their website</u>. If you have questions about the FAFSA, please contact your school counselor or Mrs. Bass for assistance.
