Updated Restroom Policy

Vaping is unacceptable behavior in our school setting. A student caught vaping, or with a vape pen, or participating in the exchange of a vape pen will continue to be suspended from school, receive an extra-curricular 'good conduct' violation and **also** be issued a ticket by the Marion Police Department. We are also letting our students know that starting Monday, January 10, there is to be only one student at a time in a bathroom stall and/or single-stall restroom. If we do find this rule to be violated, any student involved will be suspended from school for <u>one day</u>. We will post reminders for our students and share this information in our announcements as well. We understand our students value their social time together, our intent is to help them spend this time and relationship building outside of the restroom walls.

A full CPR certification course will be taught to students in all FUNDAMENTALS OF LIFETIME FITNESS (grades 9 and 10) and all LIFETIME FITNESS (grades 11 and 12) sections <u>this school year</u>. The full CPR certification course will be taught only to students in FUNDAMENTALS OF LIFETIME FITNESS (grades 9 and 10) sections in subsequent years. LMHS students must complete a CPR certification course prior to the end of grade 12 to meet LMHS and State graduation requirements.

- 1. Create an FSA ID for your student and one parent. studentaid.gov/FSA-ID
 - a. Make sure to save your username and password for future FAFSA filings and verify your email and phone number
- 2. Go to <u>www.FAFSA.gov</u> to start your application.
 - a. <u>List of items you need to file the FAFSA</u>.
 - b. File the 2022-2023 Form for students starting college in Fall 2023.
 - c. Check out the Federal Student Aid Page Dedicated to the FAFSA Process: <u>https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/filling-out</u>.
