Short-Term Framework for Building-Wide Celebrations/Recognitions/Drives/Awareness Initiatives: The following has

been developed to establish more uniform expectations and protocols for any building-wide sponsored celebrations/recognitions/drives/awareness initiatives: (The 'short-term' implies that this framework being put in place now will be followed by a 'long-term' framework for making and maintaining LMHS as a welcoming and safe school environment for all.)

- a. Only official LMHS clubs/organizations/teams/groups/classes may sponsor building-wide celebrations/recognitions/drives/awareness initiatives.
- b. All celebrations/recognitions/drives/awareness initiatives will last no longer than one week. Any extension will require administrative approval that will only be granted for unforeseen circumstances (e.g. school weather cancellations). [For national month-long celebrations (October-Breast Cancer Awareness Month, February-Black History Month, etc.), the sponsoring group will work with the administration to change the approved displays/signs/posters from any natural wear].
- c. Any celebration/recognition/drive/awareness initiative must have administrative approval no later than Tuesday of the preceding week.
- d. The celebration/recognition/drive/awareness initiative will be made known to the LMHS staff in the weekly *FYI* and to LMHS students and parents in the weekly *LMHS Updates for Students and Parents*.
- e. All signs/displays/posters must have administrative approval.
- f. All signs/displays/posters will only be in the Four Corners area extended to the double-doors in each adjacent hallway.
- g. Any student found to have damaged any approved signs/displays/posters or to be found disrupting the celebration/recognition/drive/awareness initiative will be subject to discipline.
- h. All signs/displays/posters must be removed by the sponsoring LMHS club/organization/team/group/class by Friday evening of the approved week.

 - a. Make sure to save your username and password for future FAFSA filings and verify your email and phone number
- 2. Go to <u>www.FAFSA.gov</u> to start your application.
 - a. <u>List of items you need to file the FAFSA</u>.
 - b. File the 2022-2023 Form for students starting college in Fall 2023.
 - c. Check out the Federal Student Aid Page Dedicated to the FAFSA Process: https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/filling-out.
