9th, 10th, and 11th GRADE STUDENTS SCHOOL-ISSUED COMPUTER UPDATE ON MARCH 30

All 9th, 10th, and 11th Grade students are asked to have their school-issued computers with them on Wednesday, March 30, for a building-wide computer update verification. This will take place during 4th Block/8th Period. All students will need to do is turn on their computer and log in to the district network. This is to ensure that school-issued computers are ready for the ISASP on Monday, April 4. If a student wants to log in to the network prior to Wednesday, March 30, to ensure updates take place, then there will not be a possible delay for this student to have updates completed at 3:25 p.m. Those computers that have not been logged onto the district network recently should expect to take longer to update. Those who log in to the network on a more daily basis should have little if any time needed for updates to take place.

Expected Student Rally to Support Transgender Female Athletes is planned for Friday, April 1, at 3:30 p.m.

A group of LMHS students are planning to hold a rally on **Friday, April 1, at 3:30 p.m.** at **LM Stadium** as part of a nationwide effort on this date to respond to state legislation that denies transgender females from participating in athletics. Students have made us aware of this effort and state that their focus in wanting to participate is to show support for transgender female participation in high school athletics and to speak out against recent legislation that does not allow transgender females to compete in athletics. The plan is for the rally to take place at 3:30 p.m. (after all classes have finished and to not cause any disruption to the school day) and will be at LM Stadium (an enclosed area open to only LMHS students and away from traffic). The rally will be completed by 4:00 p.m.

 - a. <u>List of items you need to file the FAFSA</u>.
 - b. File the 2022-2023 Form for students starting college in Fall 2023.
 - c. Check out the Federal Student Aid Page Dedicated to the FAFSA Process: https://studentaid.gov/apply-for-aid/fafsa/filling-out.
