We mentioned a couple of weeks ago regarding challenges being made to school-age students nationwide on Tik Toc. A current listing of challenges reads as the following. Parents, we are making you aware of what these challenges are stated to be and ask that you continue to speak with your students regarding these. Students, know that participation in any activity that involves such actions in the building toward a staff member will result in the stiffest of consequences including suspension and possible recommendation for expulsion from school. We thank everyone for your attention to this and appreciate the efforts of those students who understand this is never appropriate behavior for any school environment.

- September: Vandalize school bathrooms
- October: Smack a staff member

- March: Make a mess in the courtyard or cafeteria
- April: "Grab some eggz" (another stealing challenge)

- June: Flip off in the front office
