This Monday, September 20, LMHS is making schedule adjustments which include a consistent daily schedule, allowing for 5 minute passing times, has RTI/9th Connection at the end of day, and increases the number of lunch sections.

On Tuesday-Friday, 9th Grade students not requested nor requesting RTI and with a parent signed Form 3:38 may be dismissed at 3:25 p.m. 9th Grade students not requested nor requesting RTI and without a parent signed Form 3:38 will report to their 9th Grade Connection classroom at 3:30 p.m. each day of the week.

10th – 12th Grade students without Campus Release will have an assigned seat in the Learning Center at 3:30 p.m. If requested or requesting RTI on Tuesday-Friday, 10th-12th Grade students without Campus Release would report to the specific RTI classroom for the assigned day.

Mask Update:

LMHS will continue as we have since the start of the school year with masks being optional for students and staff. We do appreciate that whether a person chooses to wear a mask or chooses not to wear a mask has not been made an issue in the building.

A Word About Homecoming Week:

It has been a good week so far. Class time has been focused, we had one of our largest parades on a gorgeous late afternoon, the Powder Puff game had a large and enthusiastic crowd, we had a great crowd and effort at the home volleyball game as well as the girls swimming and diving meet. We are hopeful for a great night tonight and expect a large crowd at the Homecoming football game.

I will address a couple of changes that were made in the past year regarding Homecoming. We are only allowing LMHS students to attend the Homecoming Dance due to the size of the dances. The previous four Homecoming dances had the following number of students attending:

Fall of 2019: 1425 Fall of 2018: 1350 Fall of 2017: 1300 Fall of 2016: 1301

Dances of this size are enormous and larger than most of the large high schools in our state. In the short term, not having the 200+ non-LMHS guests that have attended each of the past two Homecoming dances will help make the anticipated size more manageable. As we continue to grow, we do need to keep considering how to address the size of the LMHS Homecoming Dance while still having an event available for all LMHS students which also includes our Compass Program. (One can certainly argue the wisdom of having a dance this year as the pandemic continues. We are having the dance and it will take place in the LM Main Gym on Saturday night from 8:00-10:30 p.m. It is a voluntary activity and students may certainly wear masks).

Last year we announced a change to what has been a Homecoming Court. We no longer have a court. Our Student Council helped to create the PRIDE of Linn-Mar to honor seniors nominated by staff and 12th and 11th Grade students who exemplify Perseverance Respect Integrity Determination and Empathy. This honor is made in the spring of each year as a culmination to the year and a high school career. As we continue to grow as a high school and as we work to provide a welcoming environment for all of our students, we have started to self-reflect on our school-wide events to ensure that they are inclusive and allow opportunities for all of our LMHS students. We do not want to send subtle and unintentional messages to any student that they are not to be included at LMHS. We want all students at LMHS to feel welcome and a part of all school-wide events and activities.

Tik Toc Challenge Issues

We have had some issues with students participating in a nationwide TikTok challenge encouraging students to engage in pranks and vandalism such as stealing nametags off doors, emptying or taking soap dispensers from restrooms, or stealing paper towels rolls and dispensers and other items within a school building. Our understanding is that the challenges are to progress and get more invasive and severe as it continues. This is occurring at schools throughout Iowa and the U.S. We have dealt with several students already and will continue to find those who are engaging in any vandalism and wastefulness of needed health products in LMHS. Our building custodians and lunch staff have suffered the most as they handle these issues while also working to maintain and feed students in one of the largest high school buildings in Iowa. We ask parents to help ensure your student is not participating in such behavior and we want students who may be tempted to participate to realize the effect on the workload of our custodians and lunch staff as well as the impact on personal hygiene and cleanliness if there is no soap available in restrooms. We thank everyone for your attention to this.
