Sophomores may also take the test but will need to take the PSAT again as a junior to qualify as a National Merit scholar.

The 2021 PSAT will take place on Wednesday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. at Kirkwood Linn Regional Center (1770 Boyson Road Hiawatha). The cost is \$18 and is paid at the Cashier's window. If you have any questions about the PSAT, please see Mr. Kennedy in the Counselors' office.
