## Fire Drill on April 18:

We have Fire Drill remaining at 3:20 p.m. on April 18. Our goal is always to have everyone out of building in under two minutes and to the evacuation location in four minutes. Our April 11 drill had everyone out of the building in one minute, fifty seconds.

### State of Iowa 'Conditions for Learning' Survey on April 19 (1st Period/1st Block):

LMHS students will be taking the State of Iowa 'Conditions for Learning' Survey during 1<sup>st</sup> Period-1<sup>st</sup> Block on Wednesday, April 19. Parents were sent information regarding the 'Conditions for Learning' Survey last week. The survey typically takes students between 10-15 minutes to complete.

### Serious Threat-Intruder 'Barricade and Prepare to Fight' Drill on Thursday, April 20, 2023 9:01 a.m.

At 9:01 a.m., the Intercom will ask teachers and staff to go through the 'Drill'.

Students will stay in the classroom for this drill. This is a 'NON-Active' drill. The focus is knowing what to do and where to locate yourself in the classroom. This drill will not take long but please take this seriously without creating panic. Re-emphasize Point I: Get out of the Building.

- a. It is important to simply get out of the building as quickly as possible.
- b. If there is a logjam getting out a door, go to the next closest door the point being to not wait to get out and to find the next quickest exit and get out of the building.
- c. If cannot leave the building, then barricade and prepare to fight. THIS IS TODAY'S FOCUS.

## Major Points of this 'Drill':

- a. 'Barricade': Teachers will show students what items to quickly move in front of classroom door(s) to prevent, or at least disrupt, anyone from entering the room.
- b. 'Prepare to Fight': Students will be shown where they will locate in room once they have barricaded doors. (Students would spread throughout the room and locate behind desks/tables/etc. and away from sightline of someone outside the door(s)). Students will be told to 'arm' themselves with any objects that they can use to throw/distract any perpetrator that may penetrate the barricade.
- c. 'Get out of the room and out of the building': Students will be informed the goal is still to get out of the room and out of the building as they are able. If perpetrator has been distracted/disabled enough to get out of the room, do so quickly and then get out of the building at the nearest exit.
  - Once this is done, then 1st Period/1st Block will begin.

### Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) will be given at LMHS on Wednesday, April 26:

The **Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP)** will be given to students in **grades 9, 10, and 11**. This will take place on **Wednesday, April 26**, and will have a separate schedule for this testing day. This schedule will be made available the week of April 10. ISASP testing is required of all LMHS students in grades 9, 10, and 11. 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will not have classes on Wednesday, April 26. Students with IEP testing accommodations will be notified individually of their schedule for ISASP testing to be taken on April 17 (10<sup>th</sup> only), 19<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, and 24<sup>th</sup>.
