October 25 is a Two-Hour Early Release Day

October 25 is a Two-Hour Early Release day for all Linn-Mar CSD buildings, including the high school. No afternoon RTI will be held on this day. Students in the Learning Center during 3rd Block will eat during Lunch 33. The schedule is the same as used on October 20. The link to the schedule is here:

Two Hour Early Release Schedule for October 25

October 27 – Last Day of 1st Quarter – will have options for teachers depending upon the course

The last day of 1st Quarter, October 27, will have options for teachers by course regarding the focus for the day. **Teachers will communicate with students and parents what option will take place for a particular course (Regular Class Day, Final, or RTI).** The schedule for the day will continue to be a Regular Daily Schedule, including RTI at 3:30 p.m.

Many courses will simply operate a Regular Class Day with required attendance.

Some courses will give a **Final** on this day. Teachers, by course, have the option of exempting students who have a '4' in all priority standards from taking the Final or any portion of the Final for which they have a '4'. Again, this is a teacher option, by course (the same option will be used for the same course no matter the teacher). Having a '4' does not automatically exempt a student from a Final. If a student is exempted from a Final and they have Campus Release or 3:30 Release for 9th Grade, they will be allowed to leave campus during this class period/block. 9th Grade students who do not leave campus if exempted from a Final will be required to stay in the classroom.

Some courses will have an **RTI** focus on this day, meaning that teachers in these courses will be working with those students who need the extra support prior to the end of the term. A student may be exempted from attending an RTI class session by the teacher based on quality performance in the class. Students exempted from an RTI class session who have either Campus Release or 3:30 Release for 9th Grade will be allowed to leave campus during this class period/block. 9th Grade students who do not leave campus if exempted from a Final will be required to stay in the classroom.

Our **Attendance Phone line** is (319-447-3050). Parents are asked to use this number to call regarding any absences. If for an illness, parents are asked to call prior to 8:00 a.m. or as soon as you are able. For appointments, parents call the same phone line (319-447-3050) and leave a message for when the student is to be dismissed for the appointment. Students then pick up passes for the appointment in the Deans Office to show teachers when they need to leave. Students leaving for appointments must check out from the Deans Office and then check back into the Deans Office upon return. Thank you for your help when appointments are necessary during the school day.

THE TUTORING CENTER IN THE LEARNING CENTER IS OPEN DAILY

Students wanting/needing assistance with coursework may visit the Tutoring Center before school (8:15-8:45 a.m.) or during class periods/blocks during the school day. AP Course Students

The payment window will open on October 21st for 1st semester AP classes and Exam Only sections. All students who wish to take an AP exam in May must register and pay the full \$88 exam fee by November 4th, 2022. Please remember to select "Yes" for the exam when registering. Students may still register and pay for a 1st semester or Exam Only exam during the second payment window in February 2023 for an additional fee of \$40. Please make the payment in PowerSchool under the Purchases and Payments tab to the left of the screen. You may also make your payment to Joyce Dayton in the Cashiers office.
