CONSTRUCTION ALERT: Pedestrian Bridge Over Indian Creek to Be Replaced in October

The pedestrian bridge over Indian Creek between LMHS and Armstrong Field is now closed for replacement. Users need to take the 29th Avenue bridge to cross Indian Creek during bridge replacement. The trail along Indian Creek through campus is currently being paved from south of campus to north of the LM Aquatic Center. A pedestrian bridge along the trail south of campus is being completed. Another pedestrian bridge north of the LM Aquatic Center is now being constructed.
