# Fire Alarm and Tornado Warning Evacuation Both on April 16

LMHS had a Fire Alarm caused by a defective smoke detector on April 16. We also had students and staff move to shelter locations for seventeen minutes during the Tornado Warning in the afternoon of April 16. Students who ride the bus after school were also moved to shelter locations for approximately forty-five minutes after school on April 16. Thank you to students and staff for the cooperation exhibited during these emergency situations.

# Conditions for Learning Survey will now be at 9:01 a.m. on Thursday, April 25

Due to weather-related sheltering on April 16, all LMHS students will now take the state-required *Conditions for Learning Survey* at 9:01 a.m. on Thursday, April 25, during 1<sup>st</sup> Period/1<sup>st</sup> Block classes. Again, the Conditions for Learning Survey may be taken on either school-issued computers or mobile devices.

# Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP)

The Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) will be administered to LMHS students in grades 9-11, during the mornings of **Tuesday, April 23, and Wednesday, April 24**. These are state-required exams. The schedule for these days is listed below. 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will take exams in Language and Writing, Reading, and Math. Additionally, 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will also take a Science exam. School-issued computers must be used for the ISASP.

The ISASP schedule has been created with input from students and staff to help ensure students can perform at their best on each exam. Each exam period is scheduled for seventy-five (75) minutes; however, students may take as much time as needed to complete an exam. The schedule also allows for a break after the exams each day for lunch (much like our semester exam schedule does) with classes beginning at 1:00 p.m. After the first day of testing (April 23), Periods 1-4/Blocks 1-2 will be held. On the second day of testing (April 24), Periods 5-8/Blocks 3-4 will be held. After the second day of testing, Grades 9 and 11 will not be required to report until just before the 10:45 a.m. Math exam. Students in grades 9, 11, and 12 riding the bus or being

dropped off prior to 10:45 a.m. on this day will report to the LM Main Gym until their test at 10:45 a.m. or lunch begins at 12:00 p.m.

12th grade students will not need to report to school until their class times during each afternoon.
