LMHS students, we now have a QR code and a link that can be used more easily for student reporting. The QR code will be
posted at various locations around school and the link will be made available in the Updates as well as on the LMHS webpage on
the district website.

All parents will need to log into their **PowerSchool** account to complete eRegistration. From the navigation menu, click on **FORMS** and then the **ENROLLMENT** tab. Please be sure to *complete and submit* each form, even if the information has not changed. Repeat this process for any additional students by clicking on their name in the upper left corner. It is important to have correct contact information for each student.

We are starting the school year with student legal names in PowerSchool. Per Iowa Code, if you would like for your student to use a different name, nickname, pronoun or gender identity, guardians must fill out the **Student Name Preference** form within PowerSchool (**GENERAL FORMS tab**).

Student Email Address Change

All student email addresses have been changed. Student ID #s replace the name on the student email address. Your student email address is now formatted like this: **123456@student.linnmar.org**. This change will also affect student access to Power School. The username for your student Power School account will now be your student ID#.

If you do not know your 5 or 6 digit student ID#, Parents/guardians can look this information up in PowerSchool.

- 1. Log into PowerSchool
- 2. Click on the student's name in the upper left corner
- 3. Click on "Other Information" in the lower left corner

Building Open for Students and Parents to Find Locations from 9:00-3:00 p.m.

'HOMEROOM' Sessions for All Grades Held Six Times this Year

LMHS will have Six 'Homeroom' sessions this school year on the same day for 9th-12th grades. These sessions will be from 3:30-4:00 p.m. Four of the 'Homeroom' sessions are on the first day of each term. One is also on the second day of 1st Quarter to complete Handbook verification and other required tasks and needed information for the start of the school year. One is in February for course registration and graduation preparation. These are required sessions. 'Homeroom' classroom locations will be emailed to students and posted throughout the building. The dates for 'Homeroom': August 24, August 25, October 30, January 16, February 5, and April 2. 9th Grade students will also have nine 9th Grade Connection sessions during the school year. The dates for these are listed in the 9th Grade section of the *Updates*.

School Lockers Only Assigned by Individual Sign-Up in School Counselor Officer

LMHS students are not automatically issued a school locker. This change has been made over time as few students use school lockers. Any student who wishes to have a school locker may have one assigned in the School Counselor Office.
