Safe2SpeakUp is an application on all LMHS student school-issued computers that allows a student to report something unsafe or to ask for help for a personal crisis for self or someone else at any time. Safe2SpeakUp alerts are sent directly to LMHS Administrators, Student Assistance Counselors and School Counselors. Other Information

Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL)

The Linn-Mar Community School District's voted Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL) will be on the ballot **Tuesday**, **March 5**, 2024, but district residents wanting to vote before election day are welcome to do so.

From now until 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, February 19**, <u>Linn-Mar residents</u> can request a mailed absentee ballot from the <u>Linn</u> <u>County Auditor's Office</u> by completing the necessary <u>request form</u>. Ballots will need to be returned to the county auditor's office or the ballot drop box before the polls close at 8:00 p.m. on election day to be considered for counting.

If your preference is in-person absentee voting prior to election day, that will also be an option during regular business hours at the county auditor's office beginning **Wednesday**, **February 14**. In-person absentee voting will remain available until **5:00 p.m. Monday**, **March 4**.

Should you choose to head to the polls on election day, you will need to show a valid ID before casting a ballot. The polls will be open on March 5 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. If you're unsure about your polling location, you can find it at the <u>Iowa Secretary of State website</u>.

A voted PPEL generates funds our school district can only spend for infrastructure and equipment repairs, purchases, and improvements. This levy must be renewed every 10 years by voters and is not a new tax.

Linn-Mar's voted PPEL provided the district with \$3.5 million in the past fiscal year. Those funds were used for a variety of projects, from improving school security and technology purchases, to replacing roofs and school buses.
