FAFSA Now Open

Now is the time to apply for Federal Student Aid. After a long delay, the Free Application for Federal Student Aid opened on December 31. Families can get help filing the FAFSA by reaching out to their school counselor, contacting ICAN (<u>www.icansucceed.org</u>) or attending a FREE FAFSA Workshop at Linn-Mar High School on Tuesday, January 30th. Time slots are available at 4:25, 5:10 and 5:55. Sign up at <u>https://calendly.com/Imcollegecareer/fafsa-help-night</u>. The FAFSA Priority deadline for Iowa State, University of Iowa, and University of Iowa is February 1st. To receive the maximum amount of aid available, file your FAFSA before your college's priority deadline.
