

Linn-Mar High School Updates and Announcements For Students and Parents January 5, 2024



District Policy Update

The 2023 Iowa Acts, Chapter 96 (House File 604), signed by Governor Reynolds on May 26, 2023, requires the Iowa Department of Education to develop and distribute a model policy for school districts and charter schools that, if adopted, satisfies a school district's or charter school's responsibilities under Iowa Code 279.79 established by the Act. These model policies are intended to support a school district and charter school in meeting the requirements of new Iowa Code section 279.79 and in developing policies for different grade levels that describe how a school district or charter school may discipline a student for making a threat of violence or causing an incident of violence that results in injury or property damage or assault.

Districts are required to:

- Publish the district policy on the district website (2023 Iowa Acts, Chapter 96 [House File 604], section 7, new section 279.79, subsection 1).
- Provide each parent or guardian with a copy of the policy and require the parent or guardian acknowledge receipt of the policy in writing or electronically (2023 Iowa Acts, Chapter 96 [House File 604], section 8).
- Starting in the 24-25 school year, this will be required as part of student registration via PowerSchool.

The policy can be located here - 502.15 Discipline of Students Who Make Threats of Violence or Cause Incidents of Violence. We are required by law that parents/guardians acknowledge the receipt of this policy through the student handbooks. Safe2SpeakUp is an application on all LMHS student school-issued computers that allows a student to report something unsafe or to ask for help for a personal crisis for self or someone else at any time. Safe2SpeakUp alerts are sent directly to LMHS Administrators, Student Assistance Counselors and School Counselors. Thanks to some hard work and efforts by some of our LMHS students, we now have a QR code and a link that can be used more easily for student reporting. 1st Semester Exam Schedule (January 9-11, 2024) Important Information Regarding Semester Exams:

- All classes will be having a final assessment during the scheduled time.
- Students are only required to be on campus for scheduled exam sessions.
- Students late to an exam will not be allowed into exam sessions so please plan accordingly.
- Students will be allowed in the South Commons/Cafeteria when not taking exams.
- Students will only be allowed in hallways during exams with a staff escort.

¹⁴ Semester Exam Schedule Weather Contingency Plans (January 9-11, 2024)

- Busses depart at 4:05 p.m. on January 9, and at 12:20 p.m. on January 10 and 11.
- If an exam session will be an RTI session for a course, the teacher will inform students and parents by December 20
- Teachers will inform students and parents by January 5, 2024, what the *Individual Course Weather Contingency Plan* will be in the event all weather contingencies are exhausted and an exam session is cancelled due to weather.
- Teachers will not change exam day/time without a Change of Semester Exam Form signed by the Principal or Associate Principals. Any needed request for an exam day/period change must be made by a parent/guardian to the Principal or Associate Principals.

Depression Screening Available the Week of January 22, 2024

The teen years are marked by a rollercoaster ride of emotions – difficult for teens, their parents, and educators. Linn Mar Counselors will be offering Depression Screening the week of January 22 with parental informed consent. They are focusing on 9th and 10th grades for screenings; however, 11th and 12th students will be screened upon parent request also. This tool cannot provide a diagnosis of depression, but it does give an indication of whether a young person should be referred for evaluation by a mental health professional. 12th Grade – LMHS Class of 2024

Iowa Seal of Biliteracy Testing on January 19:

The first LMHS testing session for the **Iowa Seal of Biliteracy** will happen on **Friday, January 19.** French will be in the morning and Spanish in the afternoon.

To qualify for the Seal, a student must have proficiency in two or more languages. A student is proficient in English if they score 18 or better on the ACT or have 561 or higher on the ISASP. We will use this information in combination with specialized tests of second language proficiency to establish biliteracy. Tests are available to students in levels 4 and 5 French and Spanish, AP French, and Intermediate I and II Spanish. Testing at lower levels is possible, though not advised. Tests are also available to native speakers of other languages (Chinese, Korean, German, etc.) that may too be proficient in English. Students earning a 3 or higher on an AP exam in a non-English language also qualify for the Seal.

All seniors (Class of 2024) who would like to test for the Seal, as well as those juniors who are in their terminal French/Spanish class this fall and would like to test for the Seal this year to place on a 2025 diploma, may sign up for the test. The sign-up is non-binding and, for those that do ultimately test, will require students to pay a \$20 testing fee to the Cashier's Office by Thursday,

January 18 <u>or to the test administrator on the day of the test</u>. Those wanting to test must contact Heather Kosikas heather.kosikas@linnmar.k12.ia.us</u> either directly or through your foreign language teacher by **Wednesday, January 17 to order** a test.

Twenty-One (21) Linn-Mar students earned the Seal in 2023. Tests have four sections including Presentational Writing, Interpretive Listening, Interpretive Reading, and Interpersonal Listening and Speaking.
