Safe2SpeakUp is an application on all LMHS student school-issued computers that allows a student to report something unsafe or to ask for help for a personal crisis for self or someone else at any time. Safe2SpeakUp alerts are sent directly to LMHS Administrators, Student Assistance Counselors and School Counselors. Thanks to some hard work and efforts by some of our LMHS students, we now have a QR code and a link that can be used more easily for student reporting. Construction Update

Demolition and preparation for construction of the Performance Venue has started. The construction area has been fenced off at this time and doors #1 and #16 are no longer accessible except as an emergency exit. Patrons coming to LMHS for events in the LM Auditorium or Little Theatre should park in the North Lot and use doors #2 and #3. Please know that Door #13 (with access from the South Lot) will not always be open except for larger events in the LM Auditorium (Musical and concerts). Thank you to everyone for your patience as this project will create the need for several adjustments until completion (end of 2025).

<u>Conditions for Learning Survey on April 17 at 3:30 p.m.</u>

All LMHS students will take the state-required *Conditions for Learning Survey* at 3:30 p.m. on Wednesday, April 17. (Parents will receive information on this survey, including an opt-out form, in a separate email sent on April 1). Seniors will take the survey and then be dismissed. 9th-11th grades will be having a short ISASP Math practice session prior to taking the *Conditions for Learning Survey*. While ISASP practice and exams must be on school-issued computers, the *Conditions for Learning Survey* may be accessed by computer or by mobile device.

Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP)

The Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) will be administered to LMHS students in grades 9-11, during the mornings of Tuesday, April 23, and Wednesday, April 24. These are state-required exams. The schedule for these days is listed below. 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students will take exams in Language and Writing, Reading, and Math. Additionally, 10th grade students will also take a Science exam. School-issued computers must be used for the ISASP. *A separate email on the ISASP will also be sent at the start of 4th Quarter in April.*

The ISASP schedule has been created with input from students and staff to help ensure students can perform at their best on each exam. Each exam period is scheduled for seventy-five (75) minutes; however, students may take as much time as needed to complete an exam. The schedule also allows for a break after the exams each day for lunch (much like our semester exam schedule does) with classes beginning at 1:00 p.m. On the first day of testing (April 23), Periods 1-4/Blocks 1-2 will be held. On the second day of testing (April 24), Periods 5-8/Blocks 3-4 will be held. On the second day of testing, Grades 9 and 11 will not be required to report until just before the 10:45 a.m. Math exam. Students in grades 9 and 10 riding the bus or being dropped off prior to 10:45 a.m. on this day will report to the LM Main Gym until 10:30 a.m.

12th grade students will not need to report to school until their class times during each afternoon.

We will be holding two ISASP practice sessions at 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 16, and Wednesday, April 17. These sessions will ensure students know the location of their exams, expectations for the exams, practice for the writing exam, and practice finding the calculator/formulas/other tools allowed for during the Math exam. On April 17, this session will also involve completing the state-required *Conditions for Learning Survey* for all four grade levels (9th-12th).

Grades 9-11 take Writing, Reading, and Math Exams. Grade 10 takes additional Science Exam. Grade 12 does not report until 1:00 p.m. each day (AP study sessions may be held for Seniors from 9:00-10:30 a.m. on April 24 at teacher discretion).

Two-Day Testing Schedule (75 minutes schedule time for each exam).

Will schedule Testing with 1st Block/1st Period Teachers (or teacher student has or has had before).

Students receiving Accommodations will take exams with Directed Studies or Roster Teachers.

ISASP Cell Phone/Computer/Smart Watch Policy:

Phones/smart watches/computers (other than for the actual test taking) are not out/used for entire 75-minute exam period, even if everyone is done with an exam. A free reading book is allowed.

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Proof of Immunization for Meningococcal

All Iowa students 16 years and older must meet the following immunization requirement *prior* to the first day of 12th grade:

• 1 dose Meningococcal (A,C,W,Y) vaccine received after age 16 years.

Please provide proof of immunization to the health office. A religious exemption is also acceptable.
