9th Grade

Signs Of Suicide Lesson During U.S. History Classes on November 15

All 9th grade students will participate in one classroom lesson which teaches them to recognize the signs of depression and suicide in themselves and others. This is a continuation of their learning that took place in the middle school on the signs of suicide. They are taught the appropriate response to these signs is to use the ACT Technique: Acknowledge that there is a problem, let the person know you Care, and Tell a trusted adult. For freshmen enrolled in US History for this semester, their lesson will take place on November 15, 2023. Parents may view the lesson content and tap into valuable resources about suicide at https://www.mindwise.org/parents/. In January, more communication will be sent on the opportunity for students to complete a Depression Screening. These screenings only occur WITH parent permission and parents will have the opportunity before that time to view the screener that is used.
