Safe2SpeakUp alerts are sent directly to LMHS Administrators, Student Assistance Counselors and School Counselors. The payment window will open on October 20, for 1st semester AP classes and Exam Only sections. All students who wish to take an AP exam in May must register and pay the full \$89 exam fee by November 3, 2023. Please remember to select "Yes" for the exam when registering. Students may still register and pay for a 1st semester or Exam Only exam during the second payment window in February 2024 for an additional fee of \$40.
