Advance Placement Course Testing Updates:

The payment window will open on October 20, for 1st semester AP classes and Exam Only sections. All students who wish to take an AP exam in May must register and pay the full \$89 exam fee by November 3, 2023. Please remember to select "Yes" for the exam when registering. Students may still register and pay for a 1st semester or Exam Only exam during the second payment window in February 2024 for an additional fee of \$40. Please make the payment in PowerSchool under the Purchases and Payments tab to the left of the screen. You may also make your payment to Joyce Dayton in the Cashiers office.

Signs Of Suicide Lesson During U.S. History Classes on November 15

All 9th grade students will participate in one classroom lesson which teaches them to recognize the signs of depression and suicide in themselves and others. This is a continuation of their learning that took place in the middle school on the signs of suicide. They are taught the appropriate response to these signs is to use the ACT Technique: Acknowledge that there is a problem, let the person know you Care, and Tell a trusted adult. For freshmen enrolled in US History for this semester, their lesson will take place on November 15.
