Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Payments for 2nd Semester Classes Due March 5, 2025

The window for AP exam payments for 2nd Semester Only Classes will be from **Monday, February 17 – Wednesday, March 5**. All students in 2nd Semester Only Classes who plan to take an AP exam in May must register and pay the full \$90 exam fee by March 5, 2025. Please make sure the selection on AP Classroom reads 'YES' for the exam when you are registering. Please **make the** payment in PowerSchool under the Purchases and Payments tab to the left of the screen. Payments may also be made to Joyce Dayton in the Cashier's Office.

Students may still register and pay for a 1st semester or Exam Only exam during the second payment window for an additional late registration fee of \$40.

To get started on your FAFSA:

Visit **<u>FAFSA.gov</u>** to begin the application process.

You will need the student's personal information, including their social security number, as well as parent(s)/guardian(s)' tax information for the previous year. It's a good idea to set aside 30-60 minutes to complete the FAFSA. You can save your progress and come back to it later, if needed. Preschool Registration is Now Open

PowerSchool is offering two years of complimentary identity protection services to students and educators whose information was involved in their data breach in December.

PowerSchool has contracted with a credit agency called Experian to contact all individuals impacted by this breach and inform them of how to enroll in these services.
