If you leave a message close to the time the notifications are sent, then you may still receive a call. These **email** and text notifications will be sent to parents at 12:30 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. each day. While the notifications are part of meeting the state requirement for attendance, they are not related to the categorizing of a student absence. The school will continue to make in person calls to notify parents as soon as possible of absences without parent notification.

Depression Screening Available the Week of January 21, 2025

The teen years are marked by a rollercoaster ride of emotions – difficult for teens, their parents, and educators. Linn Mar Counselors will be offering Depression Screening the week of January 21 with parental informed consent. They are focusing on 9th and 10th grades for screenings, however, 11th and 12th students will be screened upon parent request. This tool cannot provide a diagnosis of depression, but it does give an indication of whether a young person should be referred for evaluation by a mental health professional. Seal of Biliteracy Testing on January 17

Are you proficient in two or more languages? You could earn the Iowa High School Seal of Biliteracy! Testing will be on January 17. French students will test in the morning and Spanish students will test in the afternoon.

To qualify, you must be proficient in both English and a second language. Seniors and juniors who are in their final (Level IV or V) foreign language class, or who already have biliterate proficiency, are eligible to sign up.

ICAN FAFSA Workshop at LMHS on January 16

The FAFSA is now open! It is time to apply for Federal Student Aid. Linn-Mar is partnering with ICAN to host a FREE FAFSA Workshop at Linn-Mar High School on Thursday, January 16. Families can sign up for an hour time slot at 4:00 p.m. or 5:00 p.m.. Sign up at <u>FAFSA Night Sign-up</u>. If you are unable to attend the FAFSA night, families can get help filing the FAFSA by reaching out to their school counselor, contacting ICAN (<u>www.icansucceed.org</u>).

There are different FAFSA priority dates for colleges in Iowa. The priority date for Iowa State University is February 4, University of Iowa is February 1, and University of Northern Iowa is February 7. To receive the maximum amount of aid available, file your FAFSA before your college's priority deadline. To get started on your FAFSA: Visit <u>FAFSA.gov</u> to begin the application process. You will need the student's personal information, including their social security number, as well as parent(s)/guardian(s)' tax information for the previous year. It's a good idea to set aside 30-60 minutes to complete the FAFSA. You can save your progress and come back to it later, if needed. ICAN (<u>www.icansucceed.org</u>) in Hiawatha offers free help to get the FAFSA filled out. Reach out to them to schedule an appointment today.
