FAFSA Priority Dates

There are different FAFSA priority dates for colleges in Iowa. The priority date for Iowa State University is February 4, University of Iowa is February 1, and University of Northern Iowa is February 7. To receive the maximum amount of aid available, file your FAFSA before your college's priority deadline. To get started on your FAFSA:

Visit FAFSA.gov to begin the application process.

You will need the student's personal information, including their social security number, as well as parent(s)/guardian(s)' tax information for the previous year. It's a good idea to set aside 30-60 minutes to complete the FAFSA. You can save your progress and come back to it later, if needed. ICAN (www.icansucceed.org) in Hiawatha offers free help to get the FAFSA filled out. Reach out to them to schedule an appointment today. Please reach out to your school counselor with any questions.
