# **Menu Pricing FAQs**

Question: I thought breakfast and lunch meals are free. Why is



my child still getting charged? Answer: Your child is either buying an extra milk, an a la carte item, or their meal does not meet the free meal requirements.

Question: What are the requirements for free meals? Answer: In order for breakfast and lunch meals to be free, it must meet USDA requirements. *(ie: For breakfast, we offer four* 

menu components – milk, juice/fruit, meat/meat alternatives and grains. Students may choose three or four components in order for the items to be a meal. If they only chose one or two components, we must charge a la carte prices because the selected items do not meet USDA requirements for a complete meal.)

**Question**: Where can I see the balance or transactions on my child's account? **Answer**: Log in to Total Access to see the current balance and any transactions. If you need help logging in to Total Access, contact **Tracy Ramos**.

Question: Where do I go to add money to my child's lunch account? Answer: Log in to PowerSchool and select the purchases and payments tab on the lefthand side. It will direct you to a different website where you can select your child's name and add money under the available items. If you need help logging in to PowerSchool, please contact your school building secretary.

Even though meals are free this year, you can still fill out a **Free and Reduced application** for other possible benefits.
