Linn-Mar Students Are Making Waves In Aquatic Safety

Each year, approximately 1,500 students participate in Aquatic Experiences, the district Aquatic Safety program for elementary students. During this program, all second, third and fourth-grade students visit the Aquatic Center for five days during the school year to learn how to swim better and about aquatic safety.

The Linn-Mar Aquatic Center opened in the fall of 2013 and the Aquatic Experiences program started in the spring of 2014. When the program began, 33 percent of the district's fourth-grade students were able to pass the deep end test. In the spring of 2020, (before the district shut down due to COVID), the percentage had grown to more than 87 percent.

Enrollment Process	Lottery system opens in February and placement is determined in March. Online registration form must be submitted with all required documents to be entered into the lottery. Due to the volume of interest in preschool, not all children who apply will be placed.	Register your child for Kindergarten online through PowerSchool. Attend the Kindergarten Enrollment Fair in March to learn about JK and Kindergarten, including how to sign up for a JK screening in April. Not all students will be given a placement in JK as students are screened and only placed if their score qualifies. A year in JK is considered a year of retention.	Register your child for Kindergarten online through PowerSchool. All students who register are guaranteed a Kindergarten placement. All documents are required by August.
