We always add a FEW extra days to our school calendar in case Mother Nature decides to alter our regular schedule.

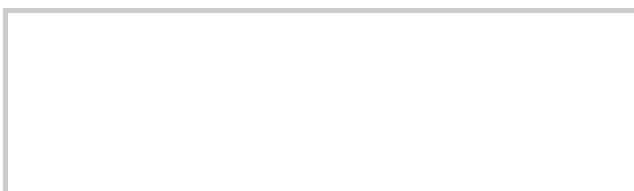
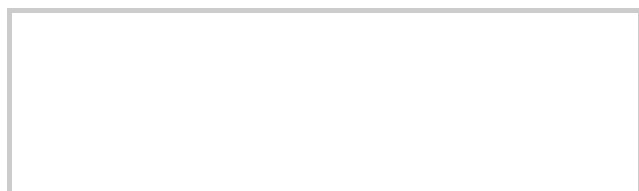


As of today, we are doing okay. (February 24)
