

## RECOGNITION-ACCOMPLISHMENTS FROM THE 2022-23 SCHOOL YEAR

- ★ Over **1,450** Linn-Mar volunteers supported Linn-Mar students, staff and programs in 2022-23. Together they logged **19,464** hours of service.
- Girls Golf qualified for State and took top honors during the MVC Valley Division meet.
- ★ Girls and Boys Track both qualified for State.
- ★ The Colton Center Jazz Ensemble **placed second** in the Class 4A lowa Jazz Championships.
- More than 500 Linn-Mar High School students participated in the lowa High School Music Association's State Solo/Ensemble Festival. Of the 273 performances by LM students, 118 received Division I (superior) ratings.
- ★ LM Future Business Leaders of America received **first place** for its fundraising efforts during the state FBLA convention by sponsoring a building-wide campaign for the March of Dimes.
- ★ Linn-Mar Football Coach Andy Strottman was named the lowa Football Association Don Taft Memorial Junior High Coach of the year in Class 5A.
- ★ Contest Speech qualified for All-State.
- ★ Linn-Mar 10th Street Edition Show Choir was named **National Grand Champions** and also awarded best vocals, best choreography, and best band.
- ★ Boys wrestling placed 4th overall in the Class 3A wrestling finals.
- ★ LINN-MAR Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee was re-invigorated in September 2021! It launched in partnership with Marion Alliance for Racial Equity (MARE), Marion Civil Rights Commission, and District DEIE Consultants. The committee included 20 members total with 11 parents, three Linn-Mar Staff, three community members, one student and two non-voting members (Board member and district Administrator.)
- ★ Varsity POMs earned their **highest finish** ever during the UDA National Dance Team Championships. The team was named **Pom Silver Medalist** among the Large Varsity Schools across the country. The team also **placed 6th** in Jazz.
- ★ Boys Swimming and Boys Wrestling **both made it to state** with several students taking individual honors.
- ★ Tonya Moe, LM Athletic Director, was selected as the 2023 Athletic Director of the Year for the State of Iowa.
