

As winter continues, we continue to focus on our School-Wide Expectations at Winter Recess. Outdoor recess with snow brings new expectations, new activities and new experiences. We've worked hard to practice snow building manners; building, adding on to and not destroying snow sculptures. We also talk a lot about responsibly with snow gear: putting on, cleaning up and always checking the lost and found.

PBIS at Home: National Random Acts of Kindness Day is February 17th, practice showing kindness throughout the day. Your kindness could be shown towards adults, friends, and community members in a variety of ways: holding doors open, giving compliments, encouraging a friend, or sharing a smile. Practice kindness and make it the new norm!



Since returning from winter break, we have been full steam ahead on our Character Strong traits. While January was very inconsistent for all of us, students and staff at Indian Creek tried our best to persevere and handle all the challenges that came our way. In January our all grade levels focused on the character trait of perseverance. Each grade level had a different area of focus when it came to perseverance which included, following directions, focusing and ignoring distractions, being engaged in their learning, being a flexible thinker and staying organized. Students learned the importance of those skills for their learning here at school, but also how they can take this learning into their lives outside of school.

Over the next few months we will be learning the traits of honesty and cooperation. As we have done for our previous traits, students will continue to focus on learning more about these words over the course of the next 8 weeks (4 weeks for honesty and 4 weeks for cooperation) not only with me in guidance, but also with their classroom teacher. My hope is that the learning they are doing here at school on all these traits is also transferring over and you as parents are seeing your students display them at home too.

It's that time of year where the snow is melting but you never know when that frigid cold weather will creep back in!

Indian Creek's lost and found is starting to fill up again! Please remember to put your child's initials or name on their coats, sweatshirts, gloves, hats, water bottles and (believe it or not) boots!
