WHAT IS A VOTED PPEL?

A voted Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL) is a voter-approved levy that generates funds a school district can use for infrastructure and equipment repairs, purchases, and improvements. Funds may be used only for these purposes.

On Tuesday, March 5, 2024, Linn-Mar Community School District voters will consider renewing the voted PPEL through 2035 at the existing rate of \$1.34 per \$1,000 of taxable property value. This levy must be renewed every 10 years to allow the district to access these funds.

WHAT IF THE VOTED PPEL IS RENEWED?

With a renewed PPEL, we would continue to address our facility and equipment needs, including:

- Repairing and replacing roofs
- Maintaining our HVAC systems
- School security improvements
- Technology purchases
- Replacing school buses
- Additional key facility projects

A voted PPEL is a cost-effective way to continue protecting the district's assets and ensure our students are provided with an exceptional learning environment today and in the future.
