



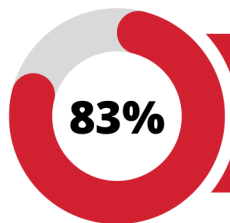

PPEL Vote, Tuesday, March 5, 2024



WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT?

On **Tuesday, March 5, 2024**, residents of the Linn-Mar Community School District will vote on a proposed Physical Plant & Equipment Levy (PPEL). This measure generates funds that Iowa school districts can use only for infrastructure and equipment repairs, purchases, and improvements.



More than 83% of the Iowa School Districts currently have a voted PPEL in place.

This is NOT A NEW LEVY,

but an extension of what's been in place at Linn-Mar CSD for more than a decade. These funds are critical toward supporting:



School security improvements



Maintaining our HVAC systems



Repairing and replacing roofs



Technology purchases



Replacing school buses



Additional key facility projects



CONTINUATION OF EXISTING LEVY

The question on the ballot March 5 asks residents to extend the voted PPEL through 2035 at the existing rate of \$1.34 per \$1,000 of taxable property value.

This will generate approximately \$3.5 to \$4.7 million each year for the next 10 years, based on the district's taxable valuation increasing by 3.5% each year.

Without a renewed PPEL, the district would need to use other funding to support building upkeep, transportation, and technology—delaying a number of potential projects planned from one-cent statewide sales tax funding (known as SAVE).
