Students may sign up for the 2024 Practice SAT, or PSAT. The PSAT is designed for juniors as a practice test and to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. Sophomores may also take the PSAT but would need to take the PSAT again as a junior to qualify as a National Merit scholar.

The PSAT will be either Tuesday October 15 or Wednesday October 16. To register for the PSAT, please pay \$18 at the Cashier's window, or your parent/guardian may pay on the Powerschool payment page.
