All students who plan to take an AP exam in May must register and pay the full \$90 exam fee by November 4, 2024. Please remember to select 'YES' for the exam when you are registering. Please make the payment in PowerSchool under the Purchases and Payments tab to the left of the screen. Payments may also be made to Joyce Dayton in the Cashier's Office. Students may still register and pay for a 1st semester or Exam Only exam during the second payment window in February 2025 for an additional fee of \$40.
