Juniors, you may sign up for the 2024 Preliminary SAT, or PSAT. The PSAT is designed for juniors as a practice college test and to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program.

The PSAT will be during the school day either Tuesday October 15 or Wednesday October 16. To register for the PSAT, pay \$18 at the High School Cashier's window, or your parent/guardian may pay on the Powerschool payment page. **The deadline for submitting payment is Friday October 4th**. Again, by making payment you will be registered, and you will receive test information the week before the PSAT.
