Simone Biles

Simone Biles is an American gymnast and one of the most decorated athletes in the history of gymnastics. Born on March 14, 1997, in Columbus, Ohio, she began gymnastics at a young age and quickly rose through the ranks due to her exceptional talent and work ethic.

Biles won seven Olympic medals, including four golds, at the 2016 Rio Olympics and the 2020 Tokyo Olympics (2021). She is known for her groundbreaking skills, including the "Biles," a problematic move that showcases her extraordinary athleticism. Biles has also had tremendous success at the World Championships, earning 19 gold medals, making her one of the most successful gymnasts in the competition's history. Beyond her athletic achievements, Biles is an advocate for mental health awareness and has spoken openly about her struggles, particularly during the Tokyo Olympics when she prioritized her mental well-being over competition. Biles has significantly impacted the sport and inspired many young athletes, especially girls, to pursue gymnastics.
